Guidance Center

Student Assistance Program

Cherry Hill Schools has provided a Student Assistance Counseling Program for many years. In addition to the traditional guidance services offered in the school the Student Assistance Program is intended to address personal issues early as a means of prevention. The Student Assistant Counselors, Mrs. Barbara Rakoczy at West, (663-8006, ext. 1216), Mrs. Jennifer Distefano, at East (424-2222, ext. 2548), and Mrs. Molly Crincoli (429-5600, ext. 455) at Malberg each have a Master's Degree in Counseling in addition to a certification as Substance Awareness Coordinators or Student Assistance Counselors (SAC).

Student Assistance is a confidential counseling program designed to help students and families with a broad spectrum of issues. The counseling program provides a safe haven for students to explore difficult and sometimes sensitive issues so they can develop a positive plan for coping or change. In the past, students have received help managing stress, parental separation/ divorce, peer conflicts, grief, eating disorders, depression, anxiety and substance abuse. Student Assistance is often viewed as family assistance, since many times the entire family is offered assistance in managing a difficult situation.

Peer support groups are also offered on a voluntary basis. Though the groups are not therapy they provide a safe environment where students may receive peer support, gain education around a specific issue or concern, and develop listening and coping skills that will assist them in both school and at home.

In addition to self-referrals, many students make contact with the Student Assistance Counselor as a result of a caring teacher, administrator, nurse, guidance counselor, friend or parent who requests an appointment for a student. If you would like to make a referral or discuss a concern, please contact the SAC in your student's school at the telephone numbers indicated above.



Scholarship Update

ABOUT LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS by Michelle Pryor, School Counselor/Scholarship Coordinator

Each year, West seniors are able to apply for over \$50,000 total worth of scholarships awarded to only West seniors. For these awards, our students compete only with each other. The criteria for each award varies. However, many require an essay, an official transcript, test scores, a resume, and in some instances an interview. The effort spent applying for these scholarships is worthwhile as the odds of receiving the award increase with this smaller pool of applicants. These scholarships are called "local scholarships." The local scholarships will now contain in the heading the words For West Seniors Only.

Some, but not all, of the local scholarships are: The Cherry Hill Rotary Scholarship, The Jon W. Dinsmore Memorial Scholarship, The Nan Lightstone Memorial Scholarship, The Lions Pride Alumni Association, The Mark Homan Foundation Scholarship, The Madeline Hyman Memorial Scholarship, and The Cherry Hill African American Civic Association Scholarship.

On a yearly basis, I contact the Cherry Hill organizations and the private donors who are often the families of the person for whom the scholarship is named, to confirm the existence of the scholarship and the current amount to be awarded. At times, the donors have wanted to discontinue the scholarship, however, I was able to convince them not to do so. Herein lies the frustration: It is so difficult to get our seniors to apply for these scholarships even though I am sure they could use the money. Despite repeated efforts to get students to apply, some of these awards have no more than one or two applicants.

Seniors, do not let the word "essay" cause you to miss an opportunity. With well-placed effort in life, you can reap rewards. Apply for as many scholarships as possible, but especially for the local scholarships.

Character Education News

Cherry Hill High School West was recently recognized by the **Character Education Partnership** for two Promising Practice awards. These are programs or ideas that are deemed of national interest as exemplars of outstanding practices for student development. Ms. Allison Staffin, Vice-principal, headed these two programs, which are continuing successfully at West. Briefly, here is a summary of the programs.

Promising Practice #1: The *PATRIOT CLUB* is a student- created, student- led and student- driven club that focuses on veteran support and appreciation both within the community and all over the world.

The *Patriot Club* was introduced formally as a club to High School West in the 2010 school year by a then senior. Prior to this, he had been working with teachers to bring veterans into the school and collect donations for military personnel overseas. As interest in these activities grew, it was formalized into a club. Each year, our students organize a day to celebrate our area veterans as close to Veteran's Day as possible. These veterans come to the building and visit history classes to share their stories and make history come alive for our students. They are hosted by our *Patriot Club* and celebrated throughout the day. Additionally, the *Patriot Club* is responsible for organizing collection drives for goods and funds to be distributed to our soldiers overseas. These packages not only include supplies and comforts from home, but a personal letter from a student in Cherry Hill.

Promising Practices: *TEEN SCENE* is a program that focuses on bringing typically developing students and students with special needs together for an inclusive teen program to further enhance the creation of a caring community.

Weekends come and go; kids are always looking for something to do. Imagine being a teenager and receiving a brightly colored flyer advertising Dinner and a Movie, Rock Band, Arts and Crafts, Bowling, Hawaiian Luau, and Get Moving. That is what *Teen Scene* is all about, bringing kids with disabilities together with their typically developing peer group. Parents of teens with disabilities are often looking for activities for their children that put them in typical teenage situations with their like peers; the inception of *Teen Scene* in Cherry Hill has enabled this to happen. Jointly with the Cherry Hill Department of Recreation and the Cherry Hill Alliance on Alcohol and Drug abuse, the community service students of Cherry Hill High School West sponsor these activities. Through an organized effort, natural leadership opportunities with the current community service students have resulted in higher participation rates and a variety of activities inclusive of all of the students that attend each *Teen Scene* event.

Congratulations to the students and Ms. Staffin for carrying on these valuable programs.
