We hope that your summer has been relaxing and enjoyable. As we prepare for the start of the new school year, we are writing to remind you of the exciting partnerships that we have with several of our local colleges and universities. These partnerships provide our students learning opportunities that will result in a college transcript. Through our dual credit options with Camden County College (CCC), Rowan College of Burlington County (RCBC), and Stockton University, our students have access to course catalogs that provide them opportunities to take classes in their high school schedule that result in a college transcript from any of the schools mentioned above. Each school provides a catalog of courses that are accepted as dual credit courses, meaning that they are taught at our buildings, and with a registration application and discounted fee students will receive a transcript from the coordinating college at the end of the school year. Please use this [link](#) to view courses your child may be enrolled in that are eligible for dual credit.

Upon satisfactory completion of course requirements, any student enrolled in this program will be able to apply this credit at those colleges/universities that accept it. All fees are paid directly to the college or university, but all paperwork is handled through our guidance department. A student may enroll in multiple classes each school year. The course selections differ between each partnering school and information is available through the links below.

In addition to our dual credit options, the course catalogs from our partnered schools are available to our students at a discounted high school rate. If there are any of these course offerings that are of interest to you please reach out to the college directly to make those arrangements. We hope that providing you and your child these opportunities will further enhance their high school experience. We encourage you to reach out to your student's guidance counselor with any questions that you have regarding these opportunities.
